

Frequently Asked Questions

- Annual event since 1978
- Approximately 3,500 people attend
- Food Court with hamburgers, hot dogs, tacos and barbecue
- 5 Zones featuring midway games (bingo, flip flop making, toy spin, etc.), sports activities (such as kapow, airborne adventure and football throw), kids games and activities (face and hair painting, sand art, porkchop speedway, etc.), a barnyard area (featuring a petting zoo and pony rides)
- Live music
- Raffle
- Silent Auction

How much does it cost?

- FREE admission and parking
- All-day Children's Activity passes are \$20 (ages 5 and up) or \$5 (ages 4 and under).
- Food tents will be on site for an additional charge. Snacks and meals range from \$2 - \$8.

Where is the festival?

Spring Festival takes place on Boys and Girls Country's main campus, which is located at 18806 Roberts Road, Hockley, TX 77447.

If you are coming from Houston traveling on 290 West, take the Katy-Hockley/Roberts Road exit and turn north (right) at the stop sign. Follow the signs to Spring Festival.

If you are coming from the Magnolia, Spring or Tomball area traveling on FM 2920, when you reach Roberts Road, head south.

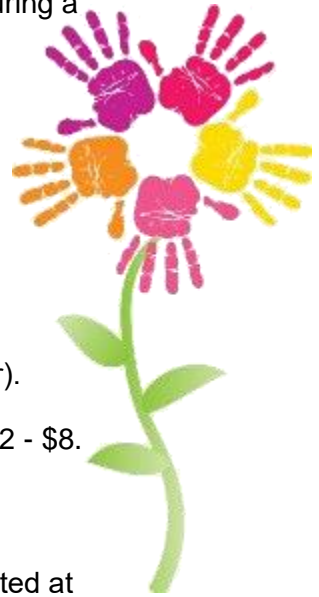
Will there be food?

Absolutely! Food tickets will be sold at all ticket booths starting at a \$1 each ticket. Visit our Food Court from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. where you will find a variety of family-friendly food and beverages ranging in price from 1 to 8 tickets.

How much does it cost to park?

Parking is Free!

The campus has plenty of parking. However, we do anticipate a large number of folks attending the festival, so go green and ride with friends.



Is handicapped parking available?

Visitors needing assistance from the parking lot to the festival entrance can request it as they enter the parking area.

Will alcohol be served?

No. While we want our patrons to have a great time at Spring Festival, we are a home for children and it is our policy not to have alcohol on our campus.

What if it rains?

Spring Festival will go on rain or shine. However, please check our website in the event of inclement weather.

What should I plan to bring with me when coming to Spring Festival?

Bring your friends and family and a smile! It is usually sunny and warm at Spring Festival, so make sure you bring sunscreen and a hat, and bug spray (non-aerosol) or lotion.

Not Allowed – Alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms, weapons, or any item resembling a weapon or firearm (including personal paint ball guns) or fireworks. Items will be confiscated and will not be returned. Violators may be removed from the Spring Festival grounds without a refund. Any illegal activity will be reported to the proper authorities. All weapons including concealed firearms are prohibited on these premises.

No Smoking – Spring Festival is a smoke free campus and the smoking of cigarettes, cigars or e-cigarettes is not allowed.

Recording Equipment – Unauthorized video cameras, tape recorders and professional camera equipment are strictly prohibited at any of the stage areas. Laser pointers are also prohibited.

To ensure patron safety, Spring Festival reserves the right to refuse admittance of any item or person deemed suspicious or offensive.

Are pets allowed at Spring Festival?

Animals can be unpredictable and may cause harm to other patrons or staff. For this reason, we ask that you do not bring animals (of any nature) to Spring Festival. The only exceptions are registered "working" animals, such as seeing-eye dogs.

Can I bring a blanket or lawn chair?

No folding chairs allowed. You may, however, bring in a blanket or towel to sit on.

Should I bring cash?

There will be no ATM machines at Spring Festival. However, all ticket booths will be set-up to accept debit/credit cards. The music artists will be selling their own merchandise and will be set-up to accept debit/credit card.

Are restrooms available at Spring Festival?

We will have portable restrooms and handwashing stations available to Spring Festival patrons.

Can I distribute pamphlets or sell items at Spring Festival?

No selling of products, services, tickets or the distribution of any information will be allowed on the Spring Festival grounds without prior written approval.

Will there be First Aid?

Yes, trained medical professionals will be hosting the Spring Festival First Aid booth.

What if I lose something?

Lost items will be held at our Information Booth at the entrance of the festival grounds. If you are not able to retrieve your lost item(s) during festival hours, please contact Boys and Girls Country Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Boys and Girls Country will not hold items longer than 30 days.
